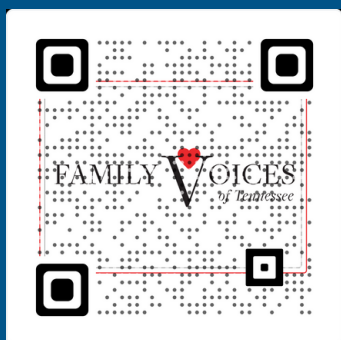

WHO WE ARE

We are families supporting families.

Our staff and volunteers all have personal experience caring for an individual with a special healthcare need, chronic illness, or disability. This personal experience helps us connect, train, and lead alongside the families we serve.

We **connect** families with each other and with community resources.

We **train** families to become advocates and leaders.

We **lead** alongside families to ensure their voices are included, heard and honored.



WHAT WE DO

Peer Support

Peers are volunteers with lived experience who receive training and provide one on one support. They're experts in their own journey managing their health needs, as caregivers or siblings, and can help share what they've learned with others.

Family-to-Family Health Information Center

Help navigating the healthcare system, including Medicaid/TennCare, Social Security for children, Children's Special Services, Early Intervention (TEIS) and more.

PEARS (Parents. Empowerment. Access. Resources. Support.)

Support for families with children who are D/deaf, hard of hearing, or experience hearing loss.
